- A professional Letter of Reference (teacher or guidance counselor)
- A character Letter of Reference (such as employer, scout leader, community leader and or neighbor)
- Official school transcript including credits and class rank

The recipient will be recognized at his or her school's awards ceremony.

The award will be dispersed after the student submits to the President of the MLT a college transcript documenting successful completion of his or her first semester in college.
